#### **ADDENDUM A**

### **Big Event Update:**

- Public relations update from Bob, Sponsorship update from Linda (all sponsorship slots are filled).
- Post cards were sent out this month. Bob picked up 500 extra post cards to distribute at various networking events. We have been notified that not all active ASTD members received the postcard and are in the process of rectifying this.
- Registration date: begins July 13. We would like to have everyone register BEFORE the event as we are expected to give a count for food, and we are not advertising a walk-in registration fee at this time. We are not going to encourage "walk-ins".
- Offer made to SHRM-Jax:
  - o The offer we gave SHRM: SHRM would pay ASTD \$3,500 for the right to have their members (up to 50 members) register for a fee of \$49. Note--This will pay for our additional expenses of larger room, food & books. If more than 50 SHRM members register for the event, SHRM would pay an additional \$50 per SHRM member registered. (The difference between the \$99 and the \$49 rate that SHRM members will receive).
  - SHRM members would register via the ASTD Website for \$49. SHRM members would receive the same package as other conference participants, including the Trust book. SHRM members would check-in via the ASTD check-in table, same as all other conference participants..
  - o SHRM would write an initial check of \$3,500 by July 1 to secure the \$49 rate. The actual number of members that attend the conference will be calculated after the event, and SHRM will be billed for the difference between 50 and this amount.
- SHRM declined our offer but was willing to post a link to their SHRM-JAX website to promote our event in exchange of us posting a link to the SHRM website on our ASTD NEFL website. This link will be on display for the months of August, September, and October.
